In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), we performed an asbestos re-inspection of the Strasburg School District 31-J. The inspection findings and asbestos management plans have been on file in the school administrative office since that time.

The EPA requires us to perform asbestos re-inspections every three years. An accredited asbestos inspector performed this re-inspection in April, 2022. An accredited management planner reviewed the results of the inspection and recommended actions we should take to safely manage each asbestos material in our buildings.

Following are the significant findings noted during the asbestos re-inspection of the school buildings:

All accessible ACBM present in the buildings was in good condition. We will continue to manage the ACM in place under the Management Plan as recommended by the accredited management planner.

The results of the initial asbestos inspection and subsequent re-inspections are on file in the management plan in the school's administrative office.
